



## Young Rail Professionals Representative

### Primary Focus

Young Rail Professionals (YRP) Representatives are members of YRP who are interested in promoting the activities of YRP, acting as a link between YRP and their own organisations.

### Main duties and Responsibilities

- Promote YRP networking and development events and ambassador programmes;
- Encourage YRP members to seek involvement on the YRP committee and become actively engaged in organising events and becoming a YRP ambassador;
- Circulate YRP literature and information within your organisation as required;
- Monthly liaison with YRP External Relationship Manager to share company announcements and initiatives which YRP can help promote or support;
- Support YRP's strategic industry promotion activities where case studies, testimonials and information might be required from young people working within the rail industry;
- Raise awareness of YRP with senior managers within their organisation and communicate opportunities for YRP Corporate Membership;
- Provide point of contact for the delivery of Corporate Membership benefits to their organisation (where organisation is YRP Corporate Member).

### Period of Appointment

To help gain momentum in our relationships we would ideally like the industry representative to be in the role for one year; prior to either extending or handing over to another member in the organisation.
